## Flushing operation:

- To turn on the machine, long press the power button on/off (1). After switching on, the machine starts the filling process automatically. Operational readiness is indicated by the green start button (3).
- To change the rinse program or activate pumping, press the rinse program icon (c) once.
- You can start the rinsing programme or pumping out by pressing the start button (3).
- If the screen is locked, hold your finger on the left side of the screen and swipe right to unlock it.



## Technician Quick Start Guide:



To enter the main menu, press the button  for the settings.

In this follow-up menu, you have quick access to the following submenus:

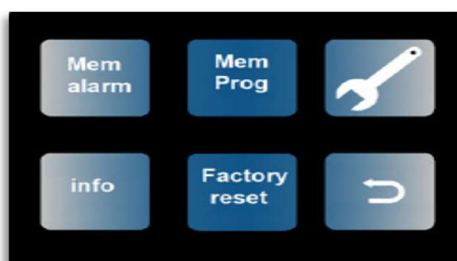


- **Language:** Change of language.
- **Detergent:** Settings for washing-up liquid and/or rinse aid
- **Service:** Access to further service information (see next table)
- **set time:** Time and date setting
- **Data:** see Firmware Update Instructions.
  - **Upload Menu:** Update display software.
    - Insert the USB stick before pressing the upload menu button.
  - **Data prog:** Load all ad software.
    - Insert USB flash drive before pressing the "Data Prog" button.
  - **Download Menu:** Download a list of all the cycles performed.
    - Plug in the USB flash drive before pressing the "Download Menu" button. (Not yet active)
- **↩Return button:** Pressing this button will return you to the previous menu.



### Service:

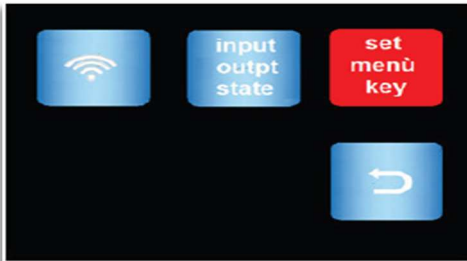
- **Mem Alert:** Fault memory
- **Mem Prog:** List of cycles performed and their result
- **Wrench Symbol:** Technician menu (see next section)
- **Info:** Current setpoints of the selected wash program
- **Factory Reset:** Currently not enabled
- **Return Button:** Return to Previous Menu





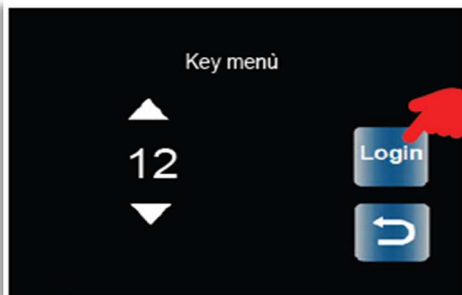
## Wrench Icon: Technician Menu

- **Wifi-Connection:** Currently not active
- **input output state:** Status of dishwasher inputs and outputs
- **Set menu key:** Changing operating parameters (see next section)
- **Return Button:** Return to Previous Menu



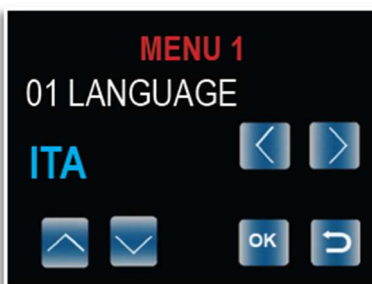
## Set menu key:

- To select the chosen menu, simply press the login button.
  - 12: Installation Menu
  - 35: Service Menu
  - 99: Display Menu



**Note:** The menus and the error codes correspond to the 3.0 series!

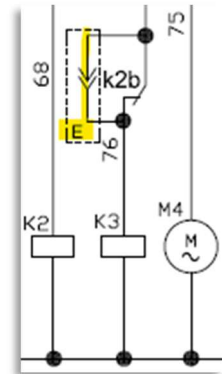
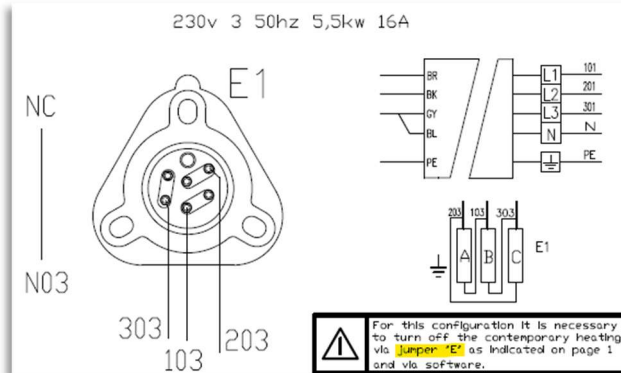
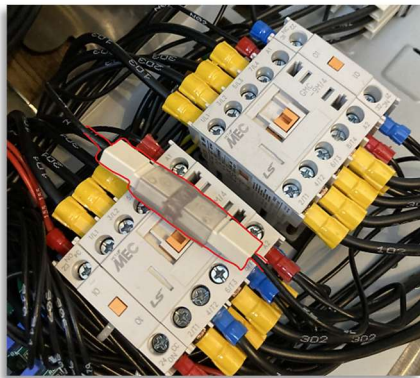
## MENU 1:



- To save and exit the selected parameter, simply press the **OK** button, or go to the next or previous parameter.

## Clamping 400/230V:

The clamping corresponds to version 3.0. On some machines, instead of menu 45 (turn off parallel heating), there may be a jamper next to the contactors. See the wiring diagram of the machine.

There are several preset programs available:




































### Voreingestellte Programmgruppen:

- Allgemeine Nutzung → P1, P2, P3, G3
- Gastronomie → P1, P4, G3, S1
- Kantine → P1, G1, B1, Pp2
- Bar/Bistro → P1, C1, C2, G2
- Feinkostgeschäft/Bistro → P2, G1, Pt1
- Feinkostladen → P2, C1, G1, Pt1
- Konditorei → P2, C1, G1, Pt1
- Gesundheitswesen → P1, PA030, PA060
- Schnellimbiss → P1, C1, Pp1, Pp2
- Feste → P1, G2, Pt1, Pp1, Pp2

- To make a change, first tap on the program icon (c). Then hold your finger and hold on the program you want to change. A new screen will appear showing "pre-set" or "Prog".
- **The "Pre-set"** allows a pre-selection that can be changed to the desired "Prog" (see the list "Preset Program Groups").

- With "**Prog**", only a single program is changed.
